Maths- I am a mathematician

We will be looking at place value and addition and subtraction.

English – I am a reader and a writer

In the first half term, we will look at fairy tales before then reading and writing about owls.

Art - I am an artist

We are going to be looking at colouring mixing before moving on to create our own owl sculptures out of clay.
