Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to everyone. It has been really good to see you all again and to see your children settling into their new classes.

Thank you for your on going support of the walk to school to and from the Dragon pub car park. Mrs Bicknell and either myself or Mr Clark are there every morning to walk back to school in all weathers! The County Times have just run an article covering the launch last week so do have a look on their website. Please can I remind all parents and carers, old and new, that the zig zag lines cannot be parked on for safety reasons. A pull up and drop off in the morning is the only time they can be paused on. Parking there makes visibility for drivers very difficult and therefore safety for children is compromised. We also have times when parked cars make it almost impossible for staff to turn in or out of the car park. By shifting to using the pub car park where possible, everyone wins.

A few start of term reminders.. Can hair be tied back in school for safety and to avoid transferring head lice which still do visit us occasionally. Please remove nail varnish and wear school shoes, not boots or anything with a heel in school.

Named water bottles should be in school containing water, not juice or squash and please remember a healthy snack for break time.

Before and after school, the bark area/ trim trail isn't to be used. This is due to safety and insurance for younger siblings that may be tempted to use it out of school hours. There is an adult on duty from 8.30 in the morning but no one is out there to supervise at the end of the day. We have clubs running in school though and need to close the gate by 3.30 each day for security. Toby will monitor the gate on a Wednesday when he is running football club in the field.

When it's raining at the start of the school day, children can come into the hall to wait before 8.40am. As it can get very busy in there, please can only Apple class parents wait with your children. If your child is in a different class and you would like to wait with them, there are other covered areas to shelter from the rain which you are welcome to use. On a Tuesday, gym club takes place in the hall until 8.40 so please can you use the other sheltered areas to wait if it's raining on that day.

Read and roast is changing. We've had lots of parents and carers join us which is really positive. In order to give a wider access than one day in the week, we will be opening it to one class at a time each day for a half term. Parents and carers can come for 11.45, then join your child/children for lunch in the central area at the 'wobbly' table. You'd then head home. We're starting with Maple class parents after October half term. If you'd like to book your session in advance, please give Mrs Oakes a call. We can seat 3 parents per day maximum. Your meal costs  $\mathcal{L}3$ , payable on the day.
