<u>Geography</u>

This term we are going to be looking at volcanoes. This will include looking at the structure of volcanoes, studying examples of volcanic eruptions and their impacts, the causes of volcanoes and the ring of fire.

Maths

We will be covering place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.

DT

Our DT unit this term is based around food. We will be looking at recipes and creating examples of roman dishes.

<u>PE</u>

The units we will cover this term are basketball, fitness, gymnastics and dodgeball.
